Through searching and analyzing various scientific journals, articles, and research reports over the past decade, this study shows that positive behavioral participation has consistently contributed to improving student learning outcomes at various levels of education. The results of this study indicate that a learning environment that supports the development of positive behaviors enhances a productive academic environment. This literature review confirms that in addition to developing the cognitive aspects of schools, strengthening positive behaviors should be an important part of the strategy to improve the quality of education.

In addition, (Reeve & Tseng, 2011) proposed that there are four aspects of student engagement, namely agentic engagement, behavioral engagement, emotional engagement and cognitive engagement. (a) Agentic engagement, which is actively contributing to building one's knowledge of the commands or tasks he receives in learning, (b) Behavioral engagement, which is the student's effort in paying attention to learning activities diligently in doing assignments, and complying with applicable school norms and rules to avoid problems, (c) Emotional engagement, illustrated by students' positive emotions in learning activities with enthusiasm or avoiding emotions irritable, restless and saturated. (d) Cognitive engagement, illustrated by controlling one's own behavior and effective ways of learning when the students themselves participate in learning.

Academic achievement is one of the important things because it is the result of an evaluation of the process of educational activities, although high achievement does not necessarily guarantee the high quality of education. So, academic achievement is intelligence in the form of knowledge (cognitive), behavior (affective), and intelligence (psychomotor) obtained through the learning process. Academic achievement is often seen from the way students learn which is influenced by two factors, namely internal and external factors. Internal factors such as attitude, intelligence, interests, talents, independence, motivation and personality, while external factors such as the social environment, and the facilities provided (JAYA, 2019).
